The is a very relaxed, leisurely tour with 5 nights in Hobart, 2 nights Launceston, 2 nights Wynyard and 1 night in Hobart again at the end.

We will be flying on Air New Zealand's direct service between Auckland and Hobart which saves connecting through Sydney or Melbourne. If, however, you would like to visit other parts of Australia before

returning home, we are happy to assist with amending your flight bookings. Air New Zealand groups will allow tour members to return from a different departure point so long as within 7 days of the main groups departure.

From our central city base in Hobart, we will be able to explore much of what Hobart has to offer. We have purposely included a lot of free time for you to follow your own interests. The MONA Art Gallery will interest some while the Botanical gardens will interest others. We have made sure that we are in Hobart on a Saturday for the weekly Salamanca Markets.

We have included breakfasts daily but not every evening meal to give you the freedom to make your own choice along the way.

We have also tried to include a wide variety of Tasmanian's highlights from the fascinating historic Hobart, beautiful East coast, the lush Tamar Valley and Launceston, and the wilderness of the North West. You will have the chance, while in Hobart to take an optional tour to Port Arthur with its, brutal history from Tasmania's Penal Colony days.

## Tues 18 April Hobart - Launceston



#### Thur 20 April Launceston - Wynyard



cancellation fee is 50% of the tour price; for cancellation less than 30 days prior to departure, full tour price may be charged.
